ABOUT CRCSP

The Court Referral Community Service Program (CRCSP) is grant funded through Douglas County, and its purpose is to benefit the community that has been harmed by an offender's crime. Judges order offenders to complete community service hours, and CRCSP refers them to agencies for completion of these hours.

CRCSP Impact



CRCSP **promotes efficiency** by eliminating the need for probation officers to spend time referring clients to agencies and verifying service hours. We refer clients to agencies, verify their hours and then report back to the probation officers.



CRCSP assists approximately 300 clients annually. With each client serving an average of 75 hours, this represents **more than 2,500 service hours for our community.**



Justice involvement, lack of a career path and lack of support can affect a client's success. This program helps remove barriers for clients; which can **reduce recidivism, probation violations and possible jail time.**

Agency Placement

United Way of the Midlands has relationships with many agencies across our community and CRCSP places all misdemeanor and felony offenses, with the exception of sexual offenses.

Transportation Assistance

We are now also offering transportation to and from agency sites through Lyft for those who have legitimate transportation needs so they can complete their service hours.
